Understanding Faith and Unbelief

≻Cause of unbelief:

- 1. Word of God not abiding in them.
- 2. Love of God not abiding in them.

Source of faith:

- 1. Word of God is abiding in you.
- 2. Love of God is abiding in you.
- Note: the love of God abides in a person because the Holy Spirit abides within them.

Abiding Spirit and Word

- NAS Ephesians 5:17 So then do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. ¹⁸ ... but be filled with the Spirit, ¹⁹ speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;
- NAS **Colossians 3:16** Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
- NAS 2 Timothy 1:13 Retain the standard of sound words which you have heard from me, in the faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.

Centrality of the Spirit

- NAS Romans 5:5 and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
- NAS 1 Corinthians 3:16 Do you not know that you are a temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?
- NAS Galatians 4:6 And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"
- NAS Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love ...
- NAS **1 John 4:13** By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.
- NIV 2 Corinthians 1:22 [God] set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

New Covenant

- NAS Ezekiel 36:26 "Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷ "And I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances.
 ²⁸ "And you will live in the land that I gave to your forefathers; so you will be My people, and I will be your God.
- NIV 2 Corinthians 1:20 For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. ²¹ Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. Bought by Christ


- NAS Hebrews 9:14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? ¹⁵ And for this reason He is the mediator of a new covenant, in order that since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were committed under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.
- NAS 1 Peter 1:18 knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, ¹⁹ but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.

Sealed by the Spirit

- NIV 2 Corinthians 1:21 Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He anointed us, ²² set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.
- NIV Ephesians 1:13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession-- to the praise of his glory.
- NIV **Ephesians 4:30** And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.




Our Obligation

- NAS 1 Corinthians 10:31 Whether, then, you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.
- NAS **Matthew 5:16** "Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.
- NAS 1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

NAS Romans 8:31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us? ³² He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?... ³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?...³⁷ But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
