



NIV John 6:59 He said this while teaching in the synagogue in Capernaum.

## **Grumbling from Within**

 NAS John 6:60 Many therefore of His disciples, when they heard this said, "This is a difficult statement; who can listen to it?" <sup>61</sup> But Jesus, conscious that His disciples grumbled at this, said to them, "Does this cause you to stumble?... <sup>64</sup> "But there are some of you who do not believe." For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who it was that would betray Him. <sup>65</sup> And He was saying, "For this reason I have said to you, that no one can come to Me, unless it has been granted him from the Father."

#### Hardened Minds

- NAS 2 Corinthians 3:14 But their minds were hardened; for until this very day at the reading of the old covenant the same veil remains unlifted, because it is removed in Christ. <sup>15</sup> But to this day whenever Moses is read, a veil lies over their heart;
- NAS 1 Corinthians 2:14 But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God; for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.



#### Life Giving Spirit


 NAS 2 Corinthians 3:2 You are our letter, written in our hearts, known and read by all men; <sup>3</sup> being manifested that you are a letter of Christ, cared for by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone, but on tablets of human hearts. <sup>4</sup> And such confidence we have through Christ toward God. <sup>5</sup> Not that we are adequate in ourselves to consider anything as coming from ourselves, but our adequacy is from God, <sup>6</sup> who also made us adequate as servants of a new covenant, not of the letter, but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life

## Words of Eternal Life


- NAS John 6:66 As a result of this many of His disciples withdrew, and were not walking with Him anymore. <sup>67</sup> Jesus said therefore to the twelve, "You do not want to go away also, do you?" <sup>68</sup> Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have words of eternal life. <sup>69</sup> "And we have believed and have come to know that You are the Holy One of God."
- NAS **John 3:16** "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life.

#### **Transforming Spirit**

 NAS 2 Corinthians 3:16 but whenever a man turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. <sup>17</sup> Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. <sup>18</sup> But we all, with unveiled face beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.









#### Never In

- NAS John 6:64 "But there are some of you who do not believe." For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who it was that would betray Him...<sup>70</sup> Jesus answered them, "Did I Myself not choose you, the twelve, and yet one of you is a devil?"
- NAS **1 John 2:19** They went out from us, but they were not really of us; for if they had been of us, they would have remained with us; but they went out, in order that it might be shown that they all are not of us.







## Power of the Spirit

- NAS **Zechariah 4:6** Then he answered and said to me, "This is the word of the LORD ... saying, 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the LORD of hosts.
- NAS **Philippians 1:6** For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.
- NAS Titus 3:4 But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared, <sup>5</sup> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,
- NAS 2 Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.
