



## Let Us

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 4:1** Therefore, let us fear lest, while a promise remains of entering His rest, any one of you should seem to have come short of it.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 4:11** Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall through following the same example of disobedience.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 4:14** Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 4:16** Let us therefore draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and may find grace to help in time of need.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 6:1** Therefore leaving the elementary teaching about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 2:10** For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things, and through whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to perfect the captain of their salvation through sufferings.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 5:9** And having been made perfect, He became to all those who obey Him the source of eternal salvation,
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 7:28** For the Law appoints men as high priests who are weak, but the word of the oath, which came after the Law, appoints a Son, made perfect forever.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:14** For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.



## Victory in Action

- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 4:34** Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to accomplish His work.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 13:1** Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He should depart out of this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.
- <sup>ESV</sup> **John 17:4** I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 19:30** When Jesus therefore had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head, and gave up His spirit.

  - The response, 22-25




## The Reason

❖<sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:19** Since therefore, brethren, we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus,

❖<sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:20** by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh,

❖<sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:21** and since we have a great priest over the house of God,

1. The risen and ascended Jesus is both the living way into God's presence and the barrier (veil) blocking the path.
  2. The death of Jesus opened the door to heaven, his ascension leads us in.
- As the perfect human in the presence of God, Jesus is the captain of our salvation.

## Jesus – the Veil of Heaven

- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 10:9** "I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 14:6** Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me.
- <sup>ESV</sup> **1 John 5:11** And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. <sup>12</sup> Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Acts 4:12** "And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men, by which we must be saved."



## Let Us Come to Jesus

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:22** let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **James 4:8** Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Matthew 11:28** "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> "Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart; and you shall find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup> "For My yoke is easy, and My load is light."
- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 6:37** "All that the Father gives Me shall come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out.



## Let Us Persevere

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:23** Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful;
- <sup>NAS</sup> **1 Corinthians 1:9** God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **1 Corinthians 10:13** No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it.
- <sup>ESV</sup> **1 Thessalonians 5:24** He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **2 Thessalonians 3:3** But the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.




## Let Us Pull Together

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:24** and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, <sup>25</sup> not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.
  - Lit., “and let us consider one another unto encouragement of love and good works, not continuously deserting the synagoguing together of ourselves ... but on the contrary continuously exhorting one another ...”
- The Bible does not recognize deliberately continuously isolated ‘Christians’ as legitimate.
  - There are many legitimate reasons to miss church, but if a person completely rejects church then they reject Christ.



- <sup>NAS</sup> **Romans 12:3** For through the grace given to me I say to every man among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has allotted to each a measure of faith. <sup>4</sup> For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function, <sup>5</sup> so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. <sup>6</sup> And since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let each exercise them accordingly: if prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith; <sup>7</sup> if service, in his serving; or he who teaches, in his teaching; <sup>8</sup> or he who exhorts, in his exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.
- <sup>NIV</sup> **John 13:35** By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:24** and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, <sup>25</sup> not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Romans 12:9** Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good. <sup>10</sup> Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor; <sup>11</sup> not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; <sup>12</sup> rejoicing in hope, persevering in tribulation, devoted to prayer, <sup>13</sup> contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality.



## Let Us Love

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Mark 12:29** Jesus answered, "The foremost is, 'Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is one Lord; <sup>30</sup> and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' <sup>31</sup> 'The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."
