







## Blood of Jesus

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 2:14** Since then the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil; <sup>15</sup> and might deliver those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives. <sup>16</sup> For assuredly He does not give help to angels, but He gives help to the descendant of Abraham. <sup>17</sup> Therefore, He had to be made like His brethren in all things, that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. <sup>18</sup> For since He Himself was tempted in that which He has suffered, He is able to come to the aid of those who are tempted.



## Blood in Hebrews 9-10

- Cycle 1

- **9:1-13** blood of Jesus → **9:14** how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?  
<sup>15</sup> And for this reason He is the mediator of a new covenant, in order that since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were committed under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

➤ *New Covenant, redemptions from sins, eternal life*



## Blood in Hebrews 9-10

- Cycle 2
  - **9:16-26** blood of Jesus → **9:27** And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this comes judgment, <sup>28</sup> so Christ also, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, shall appear a second time for salvation without reference to sin, to those who eagerly await Him.
    - *Delivered from judgment and into salvation, prepared to meet God*



## Blood in Hebrews 9-10

- Cycle 3

- **10:1-13** blood of Jesus → **10:14** For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified. <sup>15</sup> And the Holy Spirit also bears witness to us; for after saying, <sup>16</sup> "This is the covenant that I will make with them After those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws upon their heart, And upon their mind I will write them," He then says, <sup>17</sup> "And their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."

➤ *Perfected, sanctified, regenerated, members of New Covenant*



## Body of Jesus

- **NIV Hebrews 10:5** Therefore, when Christ came into the world, he said: "Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body you prepared for me; <sup>6</sup> with burnt offerings and sin offerings you were not pleased. <sup>7</sup> Then I said, 'Here I am-- it is written about me in the scroll-- I have come to do your will, O God.'" <sup>8</sup> First he said, "Sacrifices and offerings, burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not desire, nor were you pleased with them" (although the law required them to be made). <sup>9</sup> Then he said, "Here I am, I have come to do your will." He sets aside the first to establish the second. <sup>10</sup> And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all ...<sup>14</sup> because by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.



## Able to Save

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 5:7** In the days of **His** flesh, **He** offered up both prayers and supplications with loud crying and tears to the **One** able to save **Him** from death, and **He** was heard because of **His** piety.
- <sup>ESV</sup> **Hebrews 7:25** Consequently, **he is able to save** to the uttermost [forever & fully] **those** who draw near to **God** through **him**, since **he** always lives to make intercession for **them**.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 9:14** how much more will the blood of **Christ**, who through the eternal *Spirit* offered **Himself** without blemish to **God**, cleanse **your** conscience from dead works to serve the living **God**?
  - Salvation flows from the **Father** through the **Son** through the *Spirit* to **us** to the glory of the **Father**



## The Spirit and the New Covenant

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:15** And the Holy Spirit also bears witness to us; for after saying, <sup>16</sup> "This is the covenant that I will make with them After those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws upon their heart, And upon their mind I will write them," He then says, <sup>17</sup> "And their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Ezekiel 36:25** "Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. <sup>26</sup> "Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. <sup>27</sup> "And I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances.



- <sup>NAS</sup> **Isaiah 59:20** "And a Redeemer will come to Zion, And to those who turn from transgression in Jacob," declares the LORD. <sup>21</sup> "And as for Me, this is My covenant with them," says the LORD: "My Spirit which is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your offspring, nor from the mouth of your offspring's offspring," says the LORD, "from now and forever."
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Romans 8:14** For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. <sup>15</sup> For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" <sup>16</sup> The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,



- <sup>NAS</sup> **Acts 2:1** And when the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. <sup>2</sup> And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent, rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup> And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them. <sup>4</sup> And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance. ... <sup>14</sup> But Peter ... declared to them ... give heed to my words ... <sup>16</sup> ... this is what was spoken of through the prophet Joel: <sup>17</sup> 'And it shall be in the last days,' God says, 'That I will pour forth of My Spirit upon all mankind; And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, And your young men shall see visions, And your old men shall dream dreams; <sup>18</sup> Even upon My bondslaves, both men and women, I will in those days pour forth of My Spirit And they shall prophesy.




## Mission Accomplished

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:14** For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.
  - Perfected
    - End, completion, goal, purpose
    - Perfect tense – fully completed in the past with ongoing effects
  - Sanctified
    - Consecrated to God, made holy
    - Pres. part. – lit., “the continuously sanctified ones”
  - Offering
    - Gift, thanksgiving offering (eucharist)
- Christ's once for all offering has already fully achieved God's purposes for us for all eternity and so we are in a state of continuous consecration.



## Perfected

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 2:10** For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things, and through whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to perfect the captain of their salvation through sufferings.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 5:9** And having been made perfect, He became to all those who obey Him the source of eternal salvation,
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 7:28** For the Law appoints men as high priests who are weak, but the word of the oath, which came after the Law, appoints a Son, made perfect forever.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:14** For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **1 John 3:2** Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we shall be. We know that, when He appears, we shall be like Him, because we shall see Him just as He is.

- <sup>NAS</sup> **1 Peter 1:1** Peter ... to those ... who are chosen <sup>2</sup> according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, by the sanctifying work of the Spirit, that you may obey Jesus Christ and be sprinkled with His blood: May grace and peace be yours in fullest measure. <sup>3</sup> Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
- Salvation flows from the Father through the Son through the Spirit to us to the glory of the Father

## New Covenant People

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Isaiah 59:20** "And a Redeemer will come to Zion, And to those who turn from transgression in Jacob," declares the LORD. <sup>21</sup> "And as for Me, this is My covenant with them," says the LORD: "My Spirit which is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your offspring, nor from the mouth of your offspring's offspring," says the LORD, "from now and forever."
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Titus 3:4** But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared, <sup>5</sup> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,



## Perfected for All Time

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 7:19** (for the Law made nothing perfect), but on the other hand there is a bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 2:10** For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things, and through whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to perfect the Captain of their salvation through sufferings. <sup>11</sup> For both He who sanctifies and those who are sanctified are all from one Father; for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren,
- <sup>ESV</sup> **Hebrews 7:25** Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Hebrews 10:14** For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.
