

I. Woe to the Rich


• NAS James 5:1 Come now, you rich, weep and howl for your miseries which are coming upon you. ² Your riches have rotted and your garments have become motheaten. ³ Your gold and your silver have rusted; and their rust will be a witness against you and will consume your flesh like fire. It is in the last days that you have stored up your treasure! ⁴ Behold, the pay of the laborers who mowed your fields, and which has been withheld by you, cries out against you; and the outcry of those who did the harvesting has reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth. ⁵ You have lived luxuriously on the earth and led a life of wanton pleasure; you have fattened your hearts in a day of slaughter. ⁶ You have condemned and put to death the righteous man; he does not resist you.

OT Parallels

NAS Micah 2:1 Woe to those who scheme iniquity, Who work out evil on their beds! When morning comes, they do it, For it is in the power of their hands.² They covet fields and then seize them, And houses, and take them away. They rob a man and his house, A man and his inheritance.³ Therefore, thus says the LORD, "Behold, I am planning against this family a calamity From which you cannot remove your necks; And you will not walk haughtily, For it will be an evil time.⁴ "On that day they will take up against you a taunt And utter a bitter lamentation and say, 'We are completely destroyed! He exchanges the portion of my people; How He removes it from me! To the apostate He apportions our fields.'

- NAS Habakkuk 2:5 "Furthermore, wine betrays the haughty man, So that he does not stay at home. He enlarges his appetite like Sheol, And he is like death, never satisfied. He also gathers to himself all nations And collects to himself all peoples. ⁶ "Will not all of these take up a tauntsong against him, Even mockery and insinuations against him, And say, 'Woe to him who increases what is not his--For how long-- And makes himself rich with loans?' ⁷ "Will not your creditors rise up suddenly, And those who collect from you awaken? - NAS 1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I tell you a mystery; we shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, ⁵² in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. ⁵³ For this perishable must put on the imperishable, and this mortal must put on immortality.

 ²¹ The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen.


The Coming Lord is the Lord of Hosts
