



# Knowing Christ

Every Spiritual Blessing

## Back to Samaria

- <sup>ESV</sup> **John 4:1** Now when Jesus learned that the Pharisees had heard that Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John <sup>2</sup> (although Jesus himself did not baptize, but only his disciples), <sup>3</sup> he left Judea and departed again for Galilee. <sup>4</sup> And he had to pass through Samaria. <sup>5</sup> So he came to a town of Samaria called Sychar, near the field that Jacob had given to his son Joseph. <sup>6</sup> Jacob's well was there; so Jesus, wearied as he was from his journey, was sitting beside the well. It was about the sixth hour.





## The Samaritan Woman

- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 4:7** There came a woman of Samaria to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give Me a drink." <sup>8</sup> For His disciples had gone away into the city to buy food. <sup>9</sup> The Samaritan woman therefore said to Him, "How is it that You, being a Jew, ask me for a drink since I am a Samaritan woman?" (For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.)

## Jesus is ...

- Welcoming

➤<sup>NAS</sup> **John 4:9** ... (For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.) <sup>10</sup> Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water."

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Matthew 11:28** "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 3:16** "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life

## Jesus is ...

- Merciful

➤ <sup>NAS</sup> **John 4:16** He said to her, "Go, call your husband, and come here." <sup>17</sup> The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." Jesus said to her, "You have well said, 'I have no husband';

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Romans 5:8** But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **1 Peter 3:18** For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, in order that He might bring us to God ...

## Jesus is ...

- A prophet

➤<sup>NAS</sup> **John 4:19** The woman said to Him, "Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet.

- <sup>NIV</sup> **Genesis 49:10** The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs and the obedience of the nations is his.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Deuteronomy 18:15** "The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your countrymen, you shall listen to him.

## Jesus is ...

- The Christ and God

- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 4:25** The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming (He who is called Christ); when that One comes, He will declare all things to us." <sup>26</sup> Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am *He*."
- <sup>Lit</sup> **John 4:26** Jesus said to her, "I Am, the one speaking to you."
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Exodus 3:14** And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'"
- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 1:17** For the Law was given through Moses; grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ.

# Applications

## Giver of the Spirit

- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 3:34** "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure.  
<sup>35</sup> "The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.

## Source of the Spirit

- **NAS John 4:13** Jesus answered and said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water shall thirst again; <sup>14</sup> but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life."
- **NAS Isaiah 49:10** "They will not hunger or thirst, Neither will the scorching heat or sun strike them down; For He who has compassion on them will lead them, And will guide them to springs of water.
- **NAS John 7:38** "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being shall flow rivers of living water.'" <sup>39</sup> But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

- <sup>NIV</sup> **1 Peter 3:18** For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit,
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Romans 8:11** But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who indwells you.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **1 Corinthians 12:13** For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

## Worshipping in the Spirit

- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 4:21** Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, an hour is coming when neither in this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, shall you worship the Father. <sup>22</sup> "You worship that which you do not know; we worship that which we know, for salvation is from the Jews. <sup>23</sup> "But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers shall worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. <sup>24</sup> "God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

- **NAS Ephesians 2:17** And He came and preached peace to you who were far away, and peace to those who were near;  
<sup>18</sup> for through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father.
- **NAS 1 Corinthians 3:16** Do you not know that you are a temple of God, and *that* the Spirit of God dwells in you?
- **NIV 1 Corinthians 6:19** Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?
- **NAS Ephesians 2:22** in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.
- **NAS 1 Peter 2:5** you also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

- <sup>ESV</sup> **Romans 9:5** To them belong the patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Christ who is God over all, blessed forever. Amen.
- <sup>ESV</sup> **Titus 2:13** waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

## Jesus: Giver of the Spirit

- <sup>NAS</sup> **Titus 3:4** But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared, <sup>5</sup> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,

## Every Spiritual Blessing

- The Holy Spirit *is* the ultimate blessing of God, and *is* the source of all blessings.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **John 3:34** "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure. <sup>35</sup> "The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.
- <sup>NAS</sup> **Ephesians 1:3** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ...<sup>13</sup> In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation-- having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, <sup>14</sup> who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory.
